

Lee Bank

March 8, 1853

At a meeting of the directors of the Lee Bank held at their Banking house this day the following resolutions were unanimously adopted

Whereas during the last week, a draft was rec^d by the Cash^r of this Bank from Cyrus W. Field Esq of New York amounting to Eleven Hundred forty two $\frac{49}{100}$ dollars it being the balance with principle & interest due upon a draft given by E. Root & Co in 1841 of Fifteen Hundred dollars. &

Whereas the Lee Bank had given Mr Field a full discharge of the above debt, by his paying the sum of Nine Hundred forty two $\frac{7}{100}$ dollars in the year 1845

Therefore

Resolved That in the full payment of a debt by the junior partner, having been contracted in the commencement of his business life & by misfortunes rendered him unable to pay the same, is a mark of strict honesty & integrity and is worthy of all commendation.

Resolved That the foregoing resolutions be entered upon
