



Job Opportunity Public Programs Facilitator (Part-Time)

Looking for a part time job in DC? Are you enthusiastic about American history? Do you enjoy sharing your knowledge with young children and people of all ages? The Smithsonian's National Museum of American History is looking for personable, responsible people like you to join our team of program facilitators!

The Museum is seeking energetic, curious individuals who will engage visitors in exploring American history and spark personal connections to the past. Facilitators will play a key role in managing Wegmans Wonderplace, the National Museum of American History's play-based learning space for children ages 0-6 and their adult companions. Additional duties include facilitating visitor interaction with *American Experiments*, five new hands-on experience stations that will inspire visitors to discuss and actively engage in American civic life and assisting with the Museum's *History Alive!* theater programs. Additional programs may be added throughout the year. The Museum provides training in conversational facilitation and specific topics in American history.

The best qualified applicants will have experience working in an educational setting with a variety of personalities, learning styles, and age groups. They will be committed to customer service, work cooperatively, and approach new duties with grit and flexibility.

This is a Trust (non-federal) position at IS-4, Step 1. The hourly rate is \$15.54; an average day is 7-7.5 hours. Candidates must be available to work 2-4 days per week including weekends and holidays. Anticipated start date is October 17, 2017. Duration of this position varies seasonally. Interested applicants will be informed of the duration currently being offered before an interview is scheduled.
